

Additional Hints and Tips for Using All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner

1. When putting All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner into the spa water, adjust pH first. Remember to check the pH of your tap water first. Then you know where you are starting from. Adjust the water pH a little at a time, keep checking it as you go until you get the pH between 8.0 and 8.4. Remember that Spa UP will raise the PH and Alkalinity and Spa DOWN will lower the PH and Alkalinity.
2. All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner solution contains positively charged ions. Your tub's surface has a negative charge. These charges will eventually bond and you will notice a slight film develop on the surface of your tub. The benefit of this bonding is that, it creates a natural lubricant within your spa, coating your heating element, pump, seals, and your spa plumbing, allowing your tub's equipment to work more efficiently and last longer. All that you need to do is wipe the inside of your tub with a clean cloth or sponge to break this bond.
3. At times you may experience an organic smell. This simply means All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner has found contaminants and is working to eliminate them. This may also suggest that your filter requires more frequent cleaning. Make sure the pH of the spa water is between 8.0 to 8.4. Check to make sure the underside and inside of the spa cover has been cleaned. If the odor is still present after 24 hours, add a capful of Spa 56 (chlorine) into the spa water with the pump on high for 20-30 minutes should eliminate the odor.
4. We do not recommend using a 1 Micron main filter if you are using All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner.
5. All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner is compatible with ozonators, chlorine, and bromine.
6. If your water gets cloudy use a water clarifier like SeaKlear Spa Natural Clarifier, if the water still does not clear up or has a smell to it you can usually eliminate the problem by putting a tablespoon of Spa 56 in the water and let the system run with the cover off for 30 minutes. Spa 56 is compatible with All Natural Water Treatment and Conditioner.
7. Cloudy water may be caused by frequent use by a large number of bathers, deodorants, oils, lotions, sunscreen, or other products used on the skin or soap residues in bathing suits.
8. Make sure spa users and bathing suits are as clean as possible.
 - Make sure the filter has been rinsed with hot water.
 - Make sure the filtration system runs at least 6 to 8 hours a day.
 - Four to six ounces of Sea-Kleer 4 in 1 can be used to speed up recovery time.
 - Be patient, The spa water will clear up and does not have to be drained if the water is cloudy, All Natural Water Treatment & Conditioner just needs some time to do its job.

9. Clean the spa filter with the Filter Soak, so that the spa system will not be contaminated with material left in the filter.

10. When wiping down your spa, use our Penetrating Spa Cleanser or use vinegar and water or baking soda in a bucket to clean your tub out.
